We will equip you with the tools to work remotely, and we will provide the opportunity for in-person collaboration. Your exact schedule of remote vs. in office presence is to be determined. Applicants who seek academic credit or have their own funding are welcome. Legal Aid Chicago does not provide funding, but funding will be available through external funding sources such as PILI, AmeriCorps EJW, and Equal Justice America. Applications are processed and offers made on a rolling basis. **Applicants are encouraged to apply early!**
