

In 2022, Legal Aid Chicago made equal justice a reality for **22,000** clients and their families across Cook County, with a particular focus on at-risk, underserved populations.


Last year, we returned **\$19 million** to our clients by increasing their assets, helping them regain lost benefits and property, and reducing their overall debt.


OUR IMPACT
