Legal Aid Chicago attorneys, paralegals, and staff advocate for and collaborate with clients and communities.

INTERNSHIP DETAILS:

Summer internships run for **ten weeks**. Law student interns must be available **full time** during the Summer Internship Program.

Duties may include:

- Client interviews and case investigation
- Memoranda and brief writing
- Drafting of pleadings and judgements
- Court representation under Illinois Supreme Court rule 711
- Direct representation at administrative hearings
- Legal research

Our summer interns **will have a hybrid schedule**: working part-time from home and part-time from the office at 120 S. LaSalle, Chicago, Illinois. We will equip you with the tools to work remotely, and we will provide the opportunity for in-person collaboration.

Applicants who seek academic credit or have their own funding are welcome. Legal Aid Chicago does not provide funding, but funding will be available through external funding sources such as PILI and Equal Justice America.
